Information about Student Visa

<u>Note</u>: All information is based on findings and experiences of the Embassy at the time of writing. Despite all care, no guarantee can be given for completeness and accuracy.

Application:

The application has to be submitted online via <u>www.digital.diplo.de</u>. The program will guide you through the whole process.

Necessary documents in general:

- One completely filled out <u>visa application form</u>
- 1 current biometric passport photo (available at the photo booth in the Embassy for 2.000 HUF)
- Valid passport (original + one copy of the data card and all pages with entries, visa and stamps) with following requirements:
 - o its validity should exceed the duration of intended stay in German by at least 3 months
 - it must contain at least 2 blank pages
 - o it must have been issued within the previous 10 years
- Hungarian Lakcím (residence) card (original + one copy)
- Valid Hungarian residence permit (original + one copy)
- Letter of admission issued by the German university (original + one copy)
- Proof of your educational degrees obtained so far with German or English translation (original + one copy)
- Confirmation by the Hungarian university stating the subject and duration of study with German or English translation (original + one copy)
- Personal CV containing full educational history (one copy)
- Letter of Motivation in German or English (one copy)
- Proof of sufficient financial funds, minimum 992 EUR per month of your intended stay (original + one copy), see explanations below
- Proof of sufficient knowledge of German language level B 1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) (original + one copy), see below for more information
- Proof of health insurance with coverage for Germany (original + 2 copies)
- 75 EUR payable in cash in HUF or credit card (Visa-/Mastercard). Cash payments in EUR are not accepted.

Requirements for Proof of Sufficient Funds

One of the prerequisites for obtaining a visa for studying in Germany is proof of sufficient funds of the student's entire stay in Germany.

For longer-term stays, the following applies: The total contribution for the first year of stay 11.904 EUR

must be available; for further academic years, credible proof of financing is sufficient. In any case it must be ensured that you have a minimum monthly amount of 992 EUR available.

When applying for visa, you can provide evidence that you are able to meet your living costs by opening a blocked bank account. You have free choice of provider.

Other documents accepted as proof of sufficient funds are:

- Formal letter of obligation of a sponsor residing in Germany pursuant to §§ 66, 68 of the German Residence Act. A formal letter of obligation can usually obtained at the competent local alien authority in Germany. The formal letter of obligation must mention "Studienzwecke" as purpose of stay.
- Scholarship financed by a German public institution

Requirements for Proof of Sufficient Knowledge of German Language

For a student visa you must have sufficient knowledge of the language of instruction of the degree program. Generally this is proof of sufficient knowledge of German in the form of CEFR GER-examination (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) level B 1. This examination can be taken at the Goethe-Institut. Information on preparatory language courses and German tests can be obtained from the <u>Goethe-Institut</u>, <u>www.goethe.de</u>. If the language courses were not attended at the Goethe-Institut, but at another location, a test must be taken at the Goethe-Institut confirming that you have at least level B 1.

Other acceptable proofs of sufficient knowledge of German language certificates are:

- Deutsche Sprachprüfung für den Hochschulzugang ausländischer Studienbewerber (DSH)
- Test Deutsch als Fremdsprache (TestDaF)
- deutsches Abitur
- Deutsches Sprachdiplom Stufe II der KMK (DSD-II)
- Zentrale Oberstufenprüfung (ZOP)
- Kleines Deutsches Sprachdiplom (KDS) oder Großes Deutsches Sprachdiplom (GDS) des Goethe-Instituts.

If the language of instruction in Germany is English, you must prove your language skills with an appropriate IELTS or TOEFL test. The notification of admission from the German university must confirm that the language of instruction is English.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

• Kindly come to the Embassy at least 15 minutes before the beginning of your appointed timeslot and bring the already filled in application forms and all necessary documents mentioned above as original including two copies. If you arrive later than 15 minutes after the beginning of your appointed time or without filled in application forms or documentation, you won't be admitted and have to get a new appointment.
