Information about visa for marriage in Germany

General Information

The prerequisite for entering the country for marriage is that all marriage requirements are met. For this purpose it is necessary that the future spouses, before applying for a visa, first inquire at the German registry office at the place where the marriage is planned which documents are to be presented there and formally announce the marriage.

The future spouses must be able to communicate in the German. In the visa process, German language skills corresponding to level "A1" of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages of the Council of Europe must therefore be proven. The costs for fulfilling this requirement are borne by the applicant.

Documents to be submitted:

- 1 completely filled out visa application form
- 1 current biometric passport photo (available at the Embassy for 2.000 HUF)
- Valid passport (original + 1 copy of the data card and all pages with entires, visa and stamps)
- Hungarian Lakcím (residence) card (original + 1 copy)
- Valid Hungarian residence permit (original + 1 copy)
- Proof of German language skills at the level "A1" of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) or higher (original + 1 copy)
- Certificate of birth,), including German certified translation if document is not German or English (original + 1 copy)
- Proof of health insurance with coverage for Germany (original + 1 copy)

75,- EUR payable in cash or creditcard (only Visa/Mastercard) in HUF.
Cash payments in EUR are not accepted

Required documents from the spouse living in Germany:

- Identity card/passport (1 copy)
- For non-EU citizens: residence permit (1 copy)
- Proof of formal announcement of marriage issued by German registry office (original + 1 copy)
- Formal obligation letter that the costs incurred until the marriage will be according to §§ 66-68 AufenthG (original + 1 copy)
- Pay slips/proofs of income for the last 3 months (1 copy)
- Housing rental agreement or proof of ownership (1 copy)

The application will be forwarded to the locally responsible Aliens Authority in Germany. The Embassy has no influence on the processing time.

Once approval has been received, the applicant will be notified and can obtain the visa (only in person) at the Embassy. The visa is valid for three months from the date of issue. After entering the country, the applicant must immediately contact the competent Aliens Authority in order to obtain a German residence permit with longer validity.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Visa applications are accepted by appointment only. For appointments please use our <u>online</u> <u>appointment system</u> that you find on our website at <u>www.budapest.diplo.de/termin</u>
- Please be informed that in case of incomplete documentation your application cannot be accepted and a new appointment has to be booked.
- Kindly come to the Embassy at least 15 minutes before the beginning of your appointed timeslot and bring the already filled in application forms and all necessary documents mentioned above as original including two copies. If you arrive later than 15 minutes after the beginning of your appointed time or without filled in application forms or documentation, you won't be admitted and have to get a new appointment.
